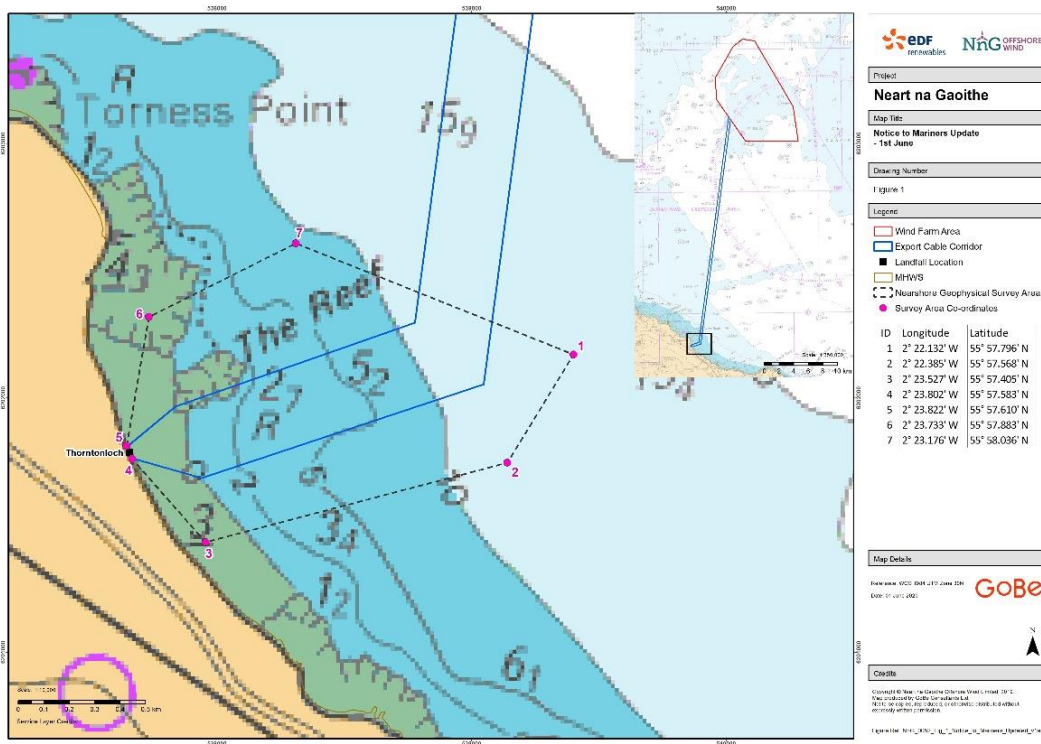


Figure 1 Export Cable Corridor and Exclusion zone for completed works

Mariners are advised that the seabed preparation vessel, *Forth Guardsman*, has now been demobilised from the nearshore area of the Neart na Gaoithe (NnG) Export Cable Corridor, shown in Figure 1.

Area of Operations

Mariners are advised that the seabed preparation vessel, *Forth Guardsman*, has now demobilised from within the nearshore area of the Neart na Gaoithe (NnG) Export Cable Corridor, shown in Figure 1.

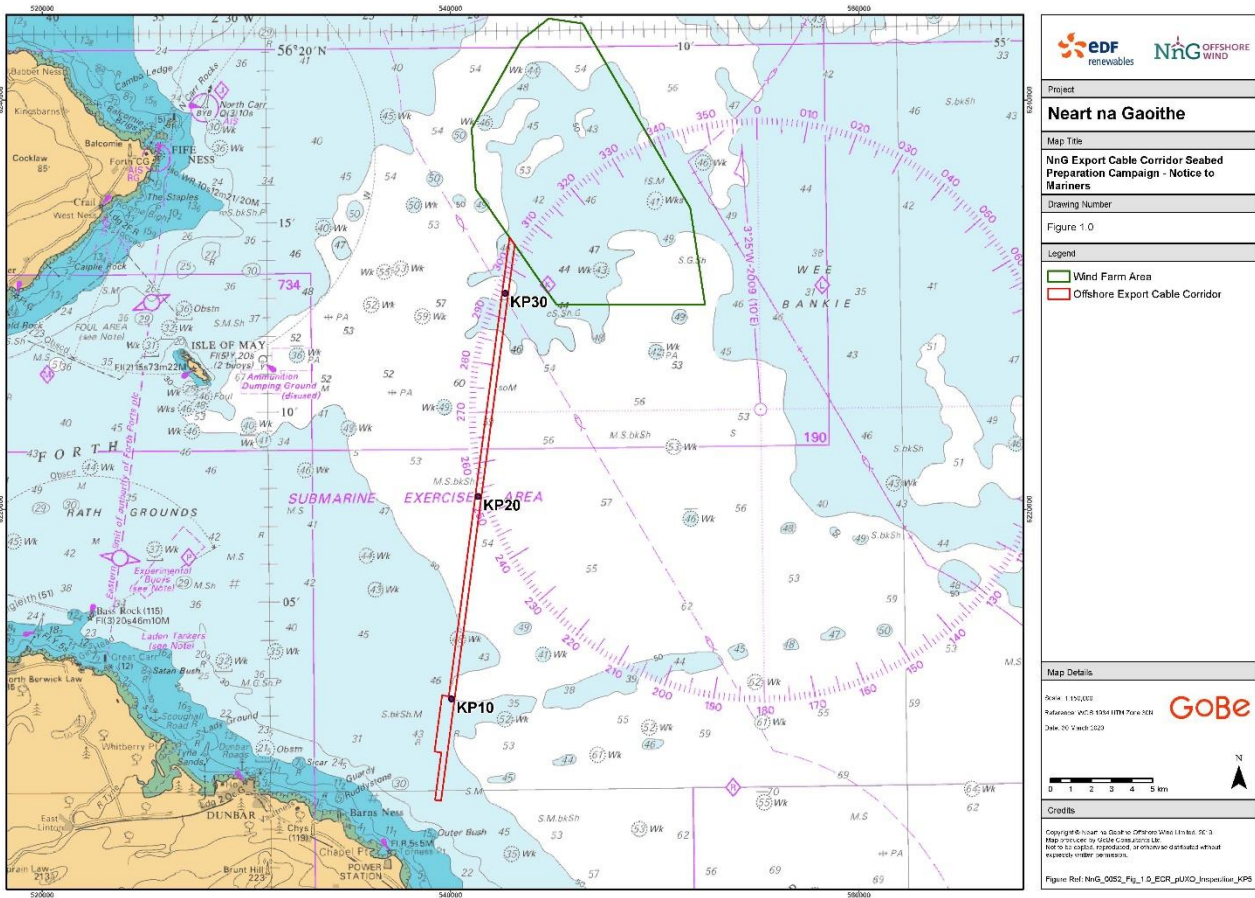


Figure 2 NnG Offshore Wind Farm Area and Export Cable Corridor (not to be used for navigation)

Seabed preparation works on the Export Cable Corridor are ongoing between KP 5 to the Wind Farm Area and within the Wind Farm Area, shown in Figure 2. Coordinates for the work remaining in the export cable corridor are provided in Table 1.

For further updates on progress, information is provided in the Weekly Notice of Operations available on the NnG project website.
