Mariners are advised that Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Farm Limited (NnGOWL) successfully deployed a Wave Rider Buoy (WRB) within the Wind Farm Area on 12th September 2020. The intention is that this buoy will remain in situ within the NnG Wind Farm site for up to two years (September 2022).

Area of Operations

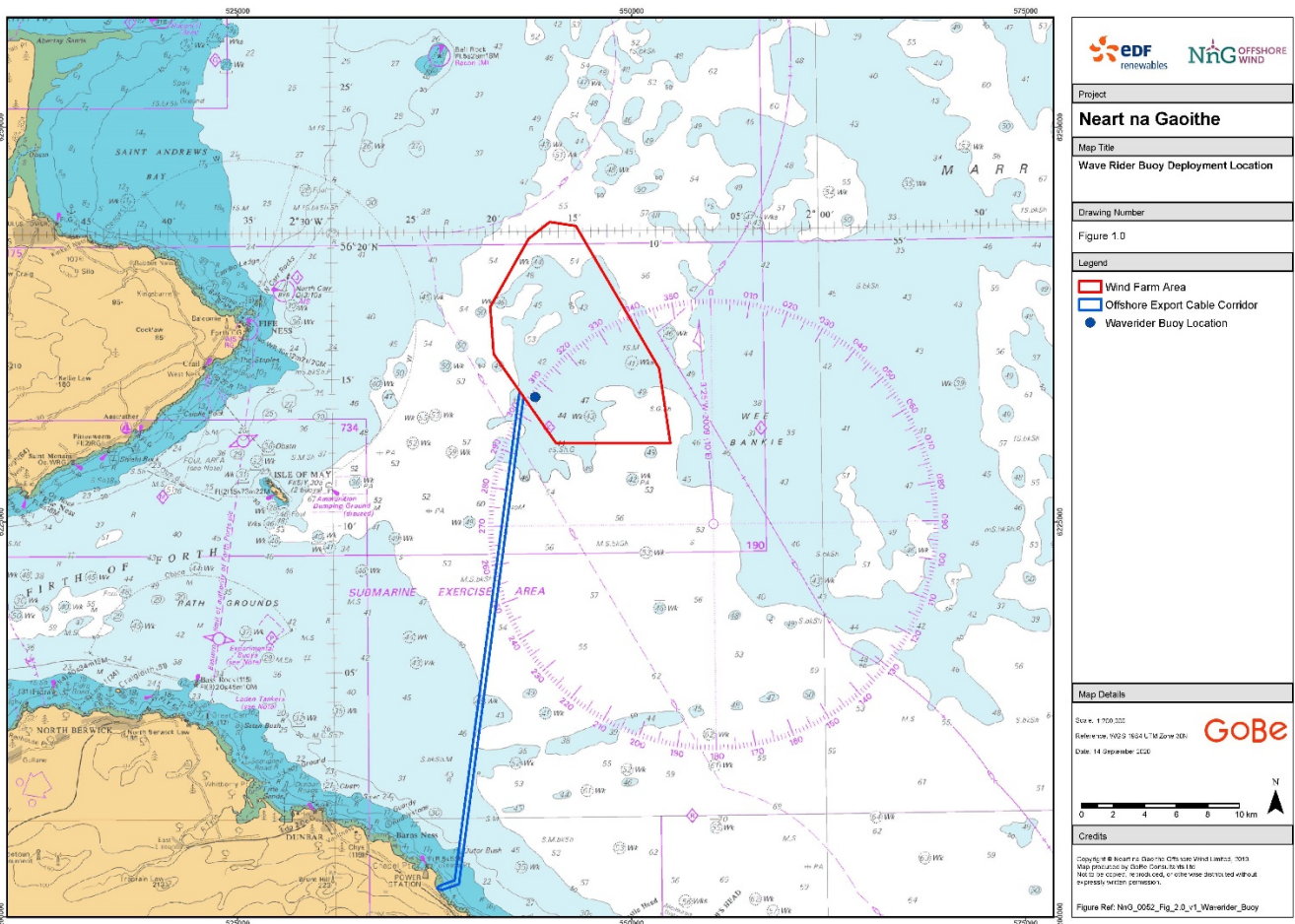


Figure 1 Wave Rider Buoy Location

The as laid coordinates of the Wave Rider Buoy are shown in Table 1 and the deployment location in Figure 1. The Wave Rider Buoy was deployed within the boundaries of the NnG Offshore Wind Farm area by the Saipem 7000 vessel.

The buoy has an antenna with a flashing yellow LED light mounted on top and is attached to the seabed with a single mooring line (polysteel rope and chain) attached to a 500 kg ballast weight.

Schedule

The buoy is collecting real-time wave and current measurements for a period of up to 24 months. The buoy will be inspected and maintained at least every six months.

Construction activities are ongoing within the boundaries of the Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Farm.
