

# Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Farm Temporary Road Closure

From Monday 19th April until Monday 3rd May, there will be a temporary road closure on the C122, between Thurston and Innerwick, as part of construction work for the Neart na Gaoithe (NnG) Offshore Wind Farm. The temporary road closure and subsequent diversions will be clearly signposted with residential access in place.



## Upcoming Road Closure



The C122 road between Thurston (at Smithy Row Cottages) and Innerwick Road will be closed between Monday 19th April and Monday 3rd May. The affected route is highlighted in **red** and the diversion is marked in **green**.

## Road repairs

NnG and its principal contractor are working closely with East Lothian Council to ensure maintenance of the public road being used for construction access between Thurston Mains Road and Woodhall Farm. Warning signs are in place and temporary repairs were carried out at the end of March. A permanent repair schedule will be agreed with the council.

## Upcoming deliveries

Abnormal load deliveries will start in April. A total of 60 deliveries (up to three deliveries per day, including weekends) will be made under escort at various locations on the cable route via the public road, construction access route, between the A1 and Crystal Rig entrance. NnG's website will be updated with the start date for deliveries once this is available.
