Subject:	Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Farm: Replacement Boulder Clearance Vessel

Mariners are advised that Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Farm Limited (NnGOWL) are due to replace the current boulder clearance vessel *Sartor*. The *Sartor* will be replaced by the *Vos Sweet* (Call Sign: PCPE) from the 10th August 2021, at the earliest. The vessel will undertake the remaining seabed preparation works within the Wind Farm Area.

The *Vos Sweet* (PCPE), will carry out the remaining boulder relocation operations in preparation for installation of the inter array cables in the Wind Farm Area. The *Vos Sweet* will be undertaking boulder relocation using a Subsea Multi-Tool Remotely Operated Vehicle with a grab.

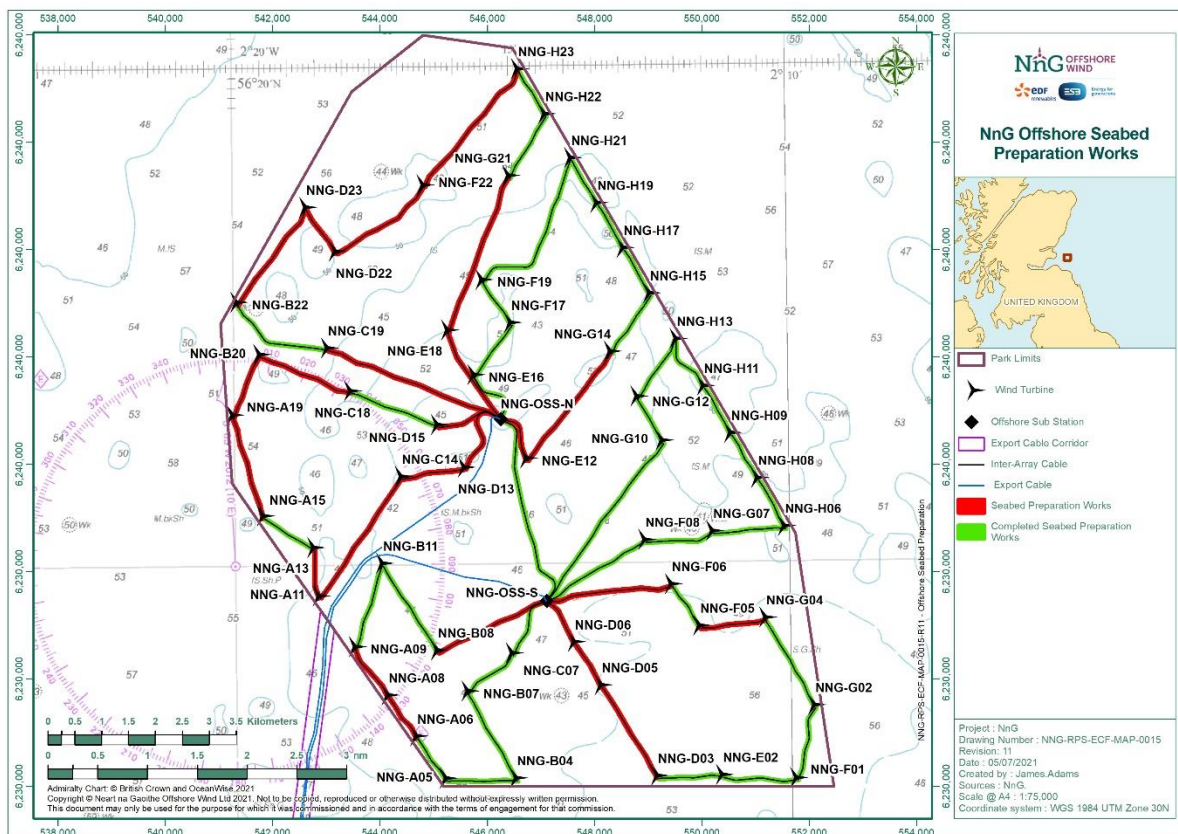


Figure 1 – Wind Farm Area showing Inter-array cable routes

Relocation of boulders in areas of inter array cable infrastructure is a critical pre-construction activity to reduce significant Health and Safety risks to the construction phase. Boulders will be relocated a short distance from their existing position only. Boulder relocation activities will take place within the Wind Farm Area in Figure 1.

Area of Operations

Mariners are advised that the *Vos Sweet* will be mobilised to work within the Neart na Gaoithe (NnG) Wind Farm Area, shown in Figure 1. The Wind Farm Area coordinates are provided in Table 1. The remaining works are expected to last approximately four months, weather dependent.

Vessels are requested to remain at least 500 metres away from the work vessel.

Schedule

The boulder relocation works commenced on the 2nd April 2021. The remaining boulder clearance works are expected to last approximately 4 months, until end December 2021, weather dependent.

It is currently anticipated that, weather permitting, construction works will be carried out on a continuous basis (i.e. 24-hour working, seven days a week) unless notified otherwise.

Vessels Associated with the Activity

Please be aware that by virtue of its mode of operation and the equipment deployed, the *Vos Sweet* will at times be Restricted in its Ability to Manoeuvre as defined under COLREGS (International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972, Rule 3). Masters of vessels are therefore requested to maintain their vessels and gears at a minimum safe distance from the *Vos Sweet* of 500 metres when it is undertaking its work and showing the appropriate shapes and lights.
