Mariners are advised that Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Farm Limited (NnGOWL) is due to commence installation of pontoons to support the operations and maintenance activities of Neart na Gaoithe (NnG) Offshore Wind Farm. The work is due to begin week from Monday 29th November 2021.

The pontoons will arrive to site via road and the majority of works will be undertaken from the quayside. A single vessel, Forth Drummer (call sign: 2FIG9) will be working within Gunsgreen Basin to lift and place the pontoons into position from week commencing 13th December 2021. The pontoons will fixed into position by attaching them to beams on the quay wall.

Area of Operations




Figure 1 – Location of pontoons Gunsgreen Basin

Mariners are advised that the *Forth Drummer* will be working within the boundaries of Gunsgreen Basin as shown in Figure 1 and the coordinates in Table 1.
