Mariners are advised that Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Farm Limited (NnGOWL) have successfully transported two components of onshore project infrastructure from Sunderland to Torness Quay via cargo barge. The barge arrived on 10th December 2021.

The components were transported on the barge, *Terra Marique* (IMO: 9281384), accompanied by a tug; *DMS Condor* (call sign: 2EHT2).

Area of Operations

The *Terra Marique* and associated tug arrived at the Torness Power Station quay as shown in Figure 1 and the coordinates in Table 1, from Sunderland.
