Subject:	Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Farm: Restarting Offshore Seabed Preparation Works
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Mariners are advised that Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Farm Limited (NnGOWL) have completed the remaining seabed preparation works within the Wind Farm Area.

The *Sartor (3ESV4)*, completed the remaining boulder relocation operations in preparation for installation of the inter array cables in the Wind Farm Area.

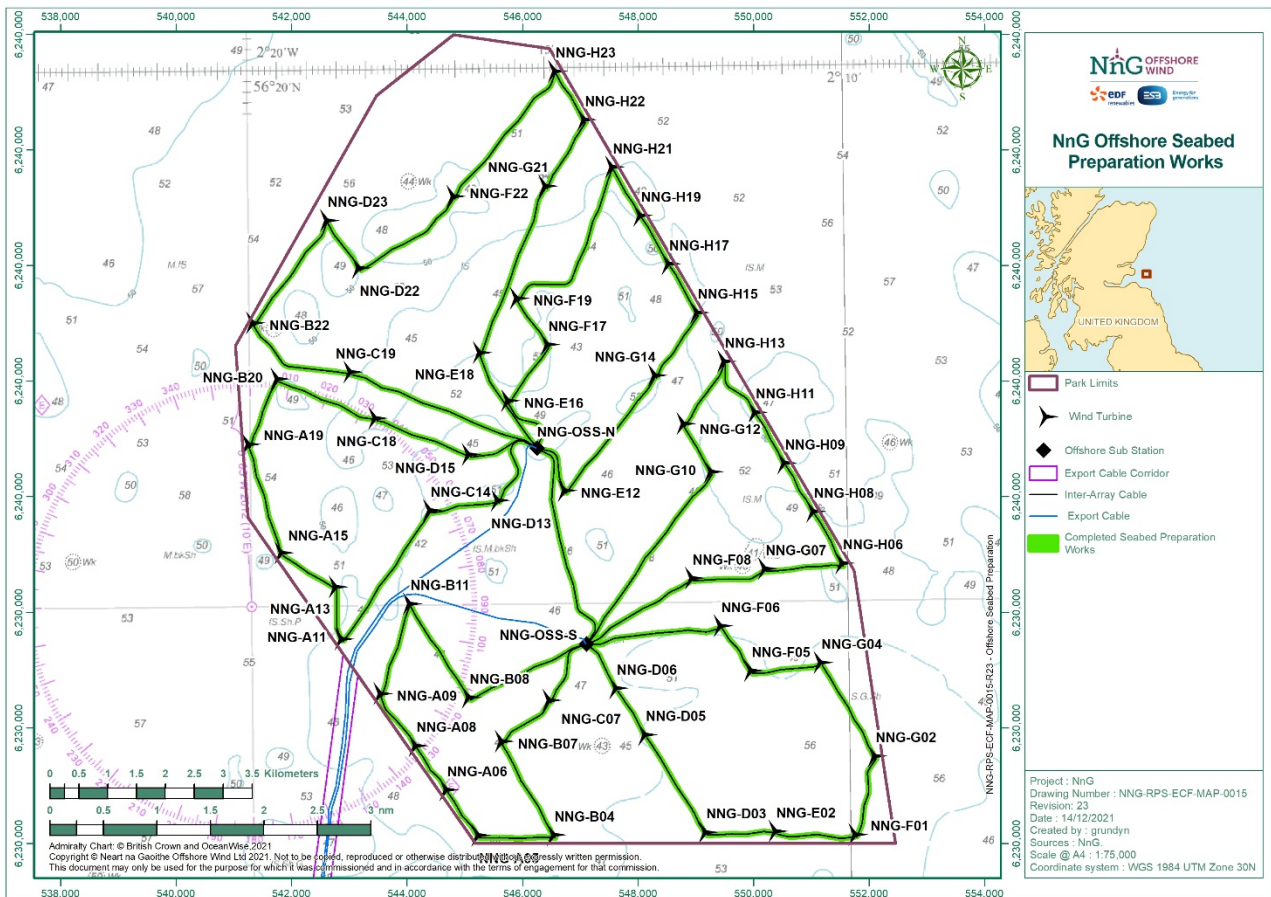


Figure 1 – Wind Farm Area showing completed boulder clearance in inter-array cable routes

Relocation of boulders in areas of inter array cable infrastructure is a critical pre-construction activity to reduce significant Health and Safety risks to the construction phase. Boulders are relocated a short distance from their existing position only. Boulder relocation activities will take place within the Wind Farm Area in Figure 1.

Area of Operations

Boulder clearance has been completed in the inter-array cable corridors as shown in Figure 1.
