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Mariners are advised the Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind North Cardinal Buoy is currently experiencing a temporary outage.

Work is ongoing to investigate the buoy and any necessary repairs will be undertaken as soon as possible. **The repair is due to be undertaken when a weather window is available, expected to be from Sunday 23rd January 2022 at the earliest. The Forth Warrior (call sign 2JHR8).** The coordinates of the buoy are provided in Table 1. A subsequent notice to mariners will be issued once functionality is restored.

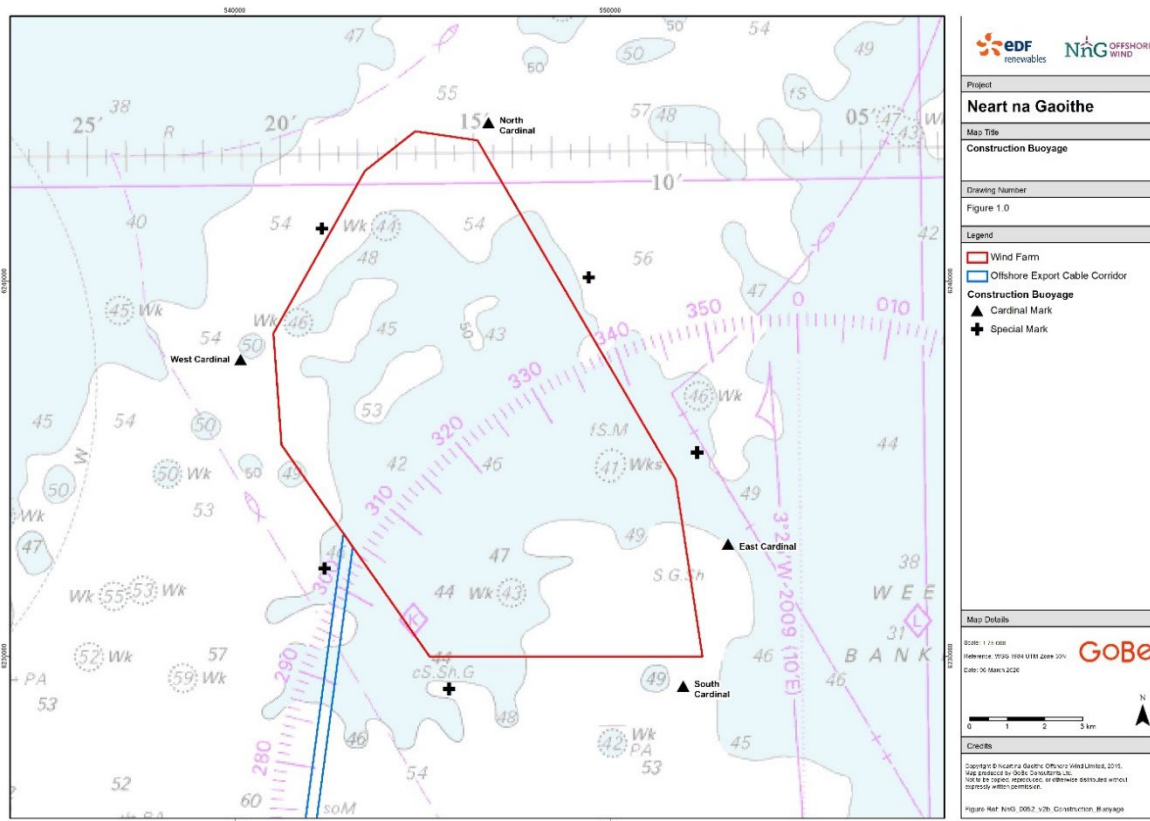


Figure 1 - As-laid positions of Neart na Gaoithe Cardinal Buoys
