Mariners are advised that Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Farm Limited (NnGOWL) are due to undertake a survey of the installed cables within the nearshore extent of the Export Cable Corridor. The works are due to commence on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> March at the earliest.

The *Celtic Guardian* (21ZH5) will undertake a multibeam survey of the two installed export cables within the nearshore area. The survey is expected to take up to two days.

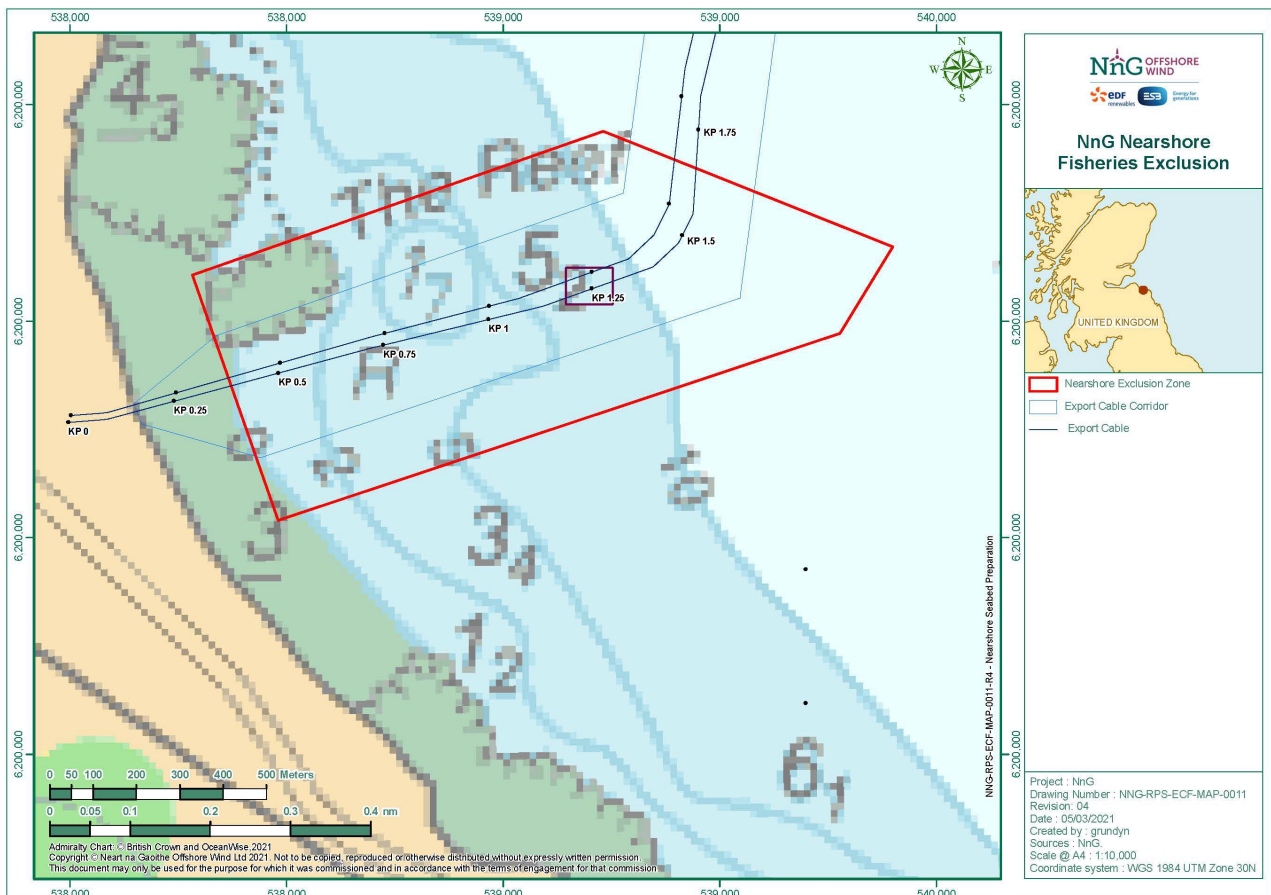


Figure 1 - Nearshore export cable exclusion areas

Vessels are requested to remain at least 500 metres away from the *Celtic Guardian* and static gear is requested to be removed from the area in Figure 1.
