Mariners are advised that maintenance has been completed on the four cardinal buoys and five special marks located around the boundaries of the Neart na Gaoithe Offshore wind Farm.

Area of Operations

The position of the four cardinal buoys and five special marks are indicated by the coordinates in Table 1, with minor updates shown in red.

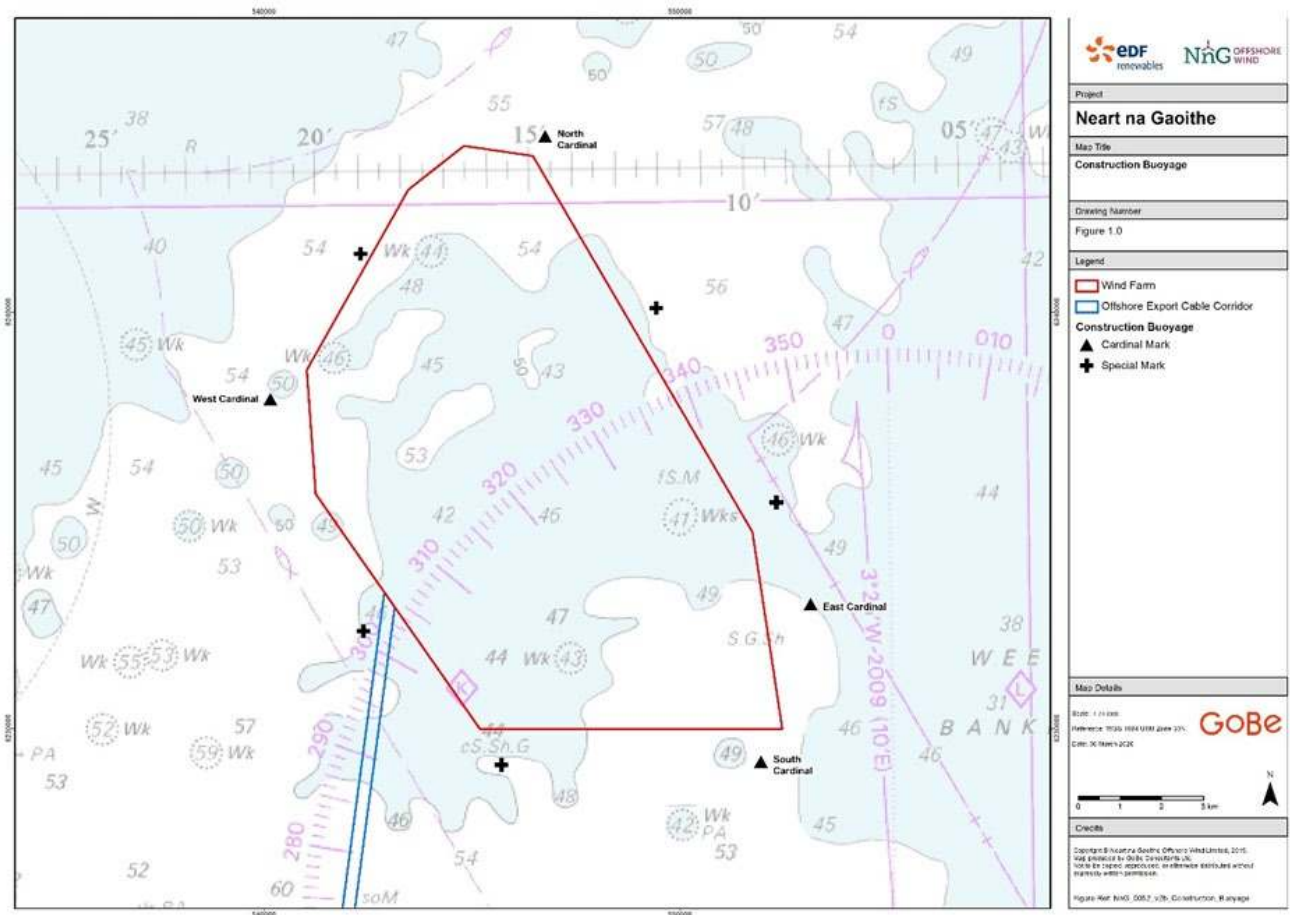


Figure 1 – As-laid positions of Neart na Gaoithe Cardinal Buoys
