Mariners are advised that the lights and AIS on all the cardinal marker buoys (North, South, East and West) located around the boundaries of the Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Farm and surrounding waters are now operational. Repair works were completed on the 8<sup>th</sup> of June, using the *Cameron* vessel (call sign: MYEK6).


The position of the two cardinal buoys due for maintenance are indicated by the coordinates in
