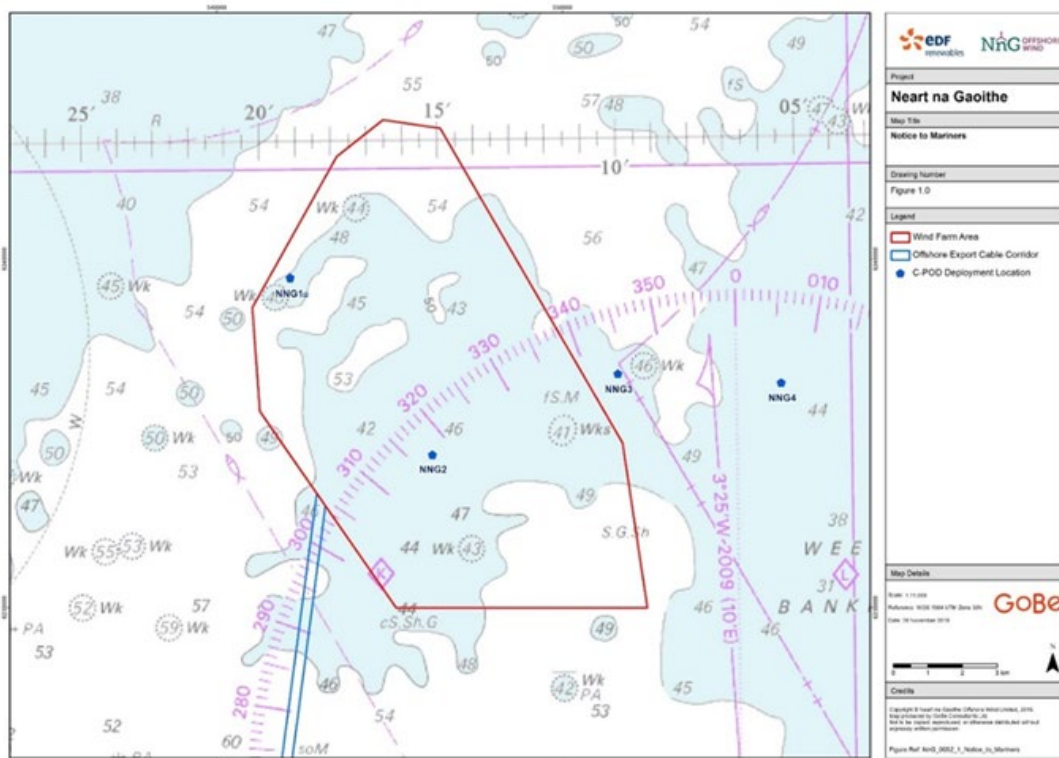


Figure 1 – Location of acoustic mooring devices

Mariners are advised that as of the 18th September 2024, there are four acoustic moorings devices located within the Neart na Gaoithe Wind Farm Area and surrounding waters, as shown in Figure 1.

(The fifth acoustic mooring (NNG1) identified in Rev3 of this NtM has since been found beyond the deployment location and brought to shore)

Area of Operations

The positions of the **four** acoustic monitoring devices are indicated by the coordinates in Table 1.

The acoustic monitoring devices are collecting real-time noise measurements for a period of 48 months. The devices will be inspected and maintained at least every four months.
